Yet, specifically for education trainers and professionals, it has also presented many obstacles, as they rely heavily on participatory methods and engagement for successful facilitations.

These obstacles have ignited a moment of reflection, in which we at GEF and within our network, have started to ask, how do we re-invent and co-create trainings and educational material in this new #era, where the emphasis is placed online? How can educational projects bring forward thinking in this particular new context?

These questions will underpin this year's **Facilitation Jumpstart- developing a green-minded toolbox** event taking place online on **Wednesday November 18th from 9h00-13h00**. This year's event is designed to provide trainers with the tools, resources, and methods they need to implement their educational projects in our new reality. It will also be the opportunity to present your skills, ideas, and work together with other participants on new project collaborations.

The objectives of the event are threefold:

- 1- Bringing the network together in one virtual room to stake stock of the biggest challenges that we face in our educational work. This will be the opportunity to share findings, learnings, and build best practices in a collaborative setting.
- 2- Identifying the needs of the future of educational projects and develop a toolbox that includes an array of resources to help implement them.
- 3- Networking opportunity to present skills, topics, and ideas to find potential project collaborations in the new online #era .

The event will allow participants to experience participatory methods first-hand and take to their future trainings.
