ABORTION RIGHTS IN EU

- Some EU Member States still have highly restrictive laws prohibiting abortion except in strictly defined circumstances
- This results in women having their sexual and reproductive health and rights denied
 - a form of gender based violence

"The European Parliament needs to protect the right and freedoms of its citizens, and strongly condemn Member States that are limiting the access to free abortions, limiting LGBTQI-rights, and ban trans people from access to healthcare and support. We cannot let the ever growing influence of anti-human rights organisations and right-wing and nationalistic politicians stand in our way."

EXAMPLE OF REGRESSION: POLAND

- In autumn 2020, the Polish constitutional tribunal ruled that the section of Polish abortion law (legislated in 1993) which allowed abortion due to foetal defects, is unconstitutional.
- This decision led to adoption of more restrictive abortion law in 2021.
- EU stated, that the constitutional tribunal had lost its independece: the ruling followed the stand of Law and Justice (PiS), a right-wing populist and nationalconservative political party in Poland.



EXAMPLE OF PROGRESSION: IRELAND

- The new abortion law in Ireland (2019) guarantees abortions until the 12th week of pregnancy without constraints.
- Previously Ireland had almost full prohibition of abortion, including victims of rape and insest.
- The new abortion law was preceded by a referendum, where the citizens voted in favour of overturning the abortion ban by 66–34.



THE STRICTEST ABORTION LAW IN EU: MALTA

 Malta, with half a million inhabitants and strong Catholic influence, is the only remaining EU member state with absolute abortion ban with no restrictions
